

# HOW TO COMPLETE YOUR LEVEL 2 BMXA OFFICIALS ACCREDITATION

Once you attend the theory component of the BMXA Level 2 Officials Course and have submitted all pre-requisites to BMXA, you are eligible to become a Prov. Level 2 Official.

## Pre-requisite requirements include:

Be a member of BMX Australia as a Volunteer, Open or Club member  
Be a BMXA Level 1 Official  
Hold a valid Working with Children Check from your State/Territory  
Completion of the ASC On-Line Community Officiating General Principles Course  
Have signed BMXA's Officials Code of Behaviour



Attend a BMXA Level 2 Officials Course.

Courses are held by the BMXA State Associations and dates of courses are available on the Officials Courses Calendar on the BMXA website or contact your State Association.

Successfully complete the theory component of the Level 2 Course.

The assessment is an Open book assessment and use may be made of the Australian Rule Book, Level 1 Officiating Manual and UCI Rules. Questions are short answer, multiple choice and true/false.



Upon successful completion of your theory workbook, your State Association will email it to [officials@bmxaustralia.com.au](mailto:officials@bmxaustralia.com.au) for processing.

**Processing may take up to 2 weeks after receipt.**

Your Officials accreditation level will be changed to Prov.Level 2



Officiate as a minimum of 3 events of Regional (R) category within 12mths of passing your Level 2 Theory and be deemed competent. If you do not complete your practical assessments within 12mths, your Officials accreditation will revert to Level 1.



Your Practical Assessments will be sent to BMXA and once processed you will become a BMXA Level 2 Official.

Your State Association will issue you with a Level 2 Officials Polo shirt.

In order to maintain your Level 2 Officials accreditation, you must at all times maintain your BMXA membership and hold an up-to-date WWCC. If any of these requirements expire, you will become an invalid official and are **NOT** covered by BMXA insurance for officiating activities.
